## Dilution Ratios:

- The following dilution ratios are recommended guidelines.  
Water is a prime factor in the cleaning process. Actual dilution ratios should be determined in each situation.

|                       |               |
|-----------------------|---------------|
| Parts Washer          | 1:1 to 1:4    |
| Engine Cleaning       | 1:1 to 1:4    |
| Heavy Grease          | 1:2 to 1:5    |
| Brake Parts           | 1:10          |
| Industrial Floors     | 1:4 to 1:9    |
| Light Grease          | 1:10 to 1:20  |
| Vehicle Washing       | 1:5 to 1:100  |
| Bilge Cleaning        | 1:10 to 1:20  |
| Restaurant Floors     | 1:8 to 1:30   |
| Grease Traps          | 1:10 to 1:20  |
| Drains & Septic Tanks | 1:20 to 1:50  |
| Household Use         | 1:10 to 1:100 |
